

April 10, 2025 – Superintendent Acknowledges Receipt of Resignation and Associated Content

On April 10, 2025, the Superintendent formally confirmed receipt of my resignation letter and explicitly acknowledged receipt of all content associated with the submission, which included documentation detailing the basis of my resignation under protest and duress. The resignation was submitted via email with an attached PDF that contained a QR code linking to an externally hosted timeline and formal complaint outlining ADA violations, discrimination, and retaliation.

Despite this acknowledgment, no attempt was made by the superintendent to address or inquire about the contents of the linked documentation, which I consider a significant procedural failure given the legal implications stated in the resignation materials.

This acknowledgment serves as direct evidence that the district was aware of my legal claims and the nature of my protest, and it further supports my assertion of constructive discharge and administrative neglect of my protected disclosures.
